


TAKE THE MILLION DOLLAR EYE TEST



THE THREE QUESTION TEST:

We have 3 very interesting questions to ask you.

Question #1 - Would you trade your right eye for a million dollars?

Of course not! No sane person would do that. You have obviously placed a very high value on your eyes. But your eyes are just the window to your soul, your soul is the real you, the eternal you.

Jesus asked this interesting question in Mark 8:36: what it would profit a man to gain the whole world and lose his own soul. He also said (Matt 5:29) it would be more profitable for a man to pluck out his right eye (if it caused him to sin) than for his whole body to be cast into hell. In other words, you should consider the value of your eyes as insignificant in comparison to the value of your soul.

Question #2 - Since you've placed such a high value on your eye, yet we know that your soul is infinitely more valuable than your eye, the real MILLION DOLLAR QUESTION is this - if on this very night God were to require your soul of you, do you know for sure where you would spend eternity?

Question #3 - As an individual finding your place in this life, have you ever asked questions like: where do I come from, why am I here or where am I going?

We believe the Bible has some definite answers to these questions... let's start with #3.

THE STORY:

God created us for a relationship...the Bible says He created us “for His good pleasure”.

He also created us to live in family when He put our original parents Adam and Eve in a beautiful home called the Garden of Eden. He told them that they were to develop the earth in partnership with Him, to name the animals, take dominion over everything He had created on earth, to subdue it, to be fruitful and to reproduce themselves until they filled the whole earth with God's glory.

I like to call this the Family Business.

Since they were created in the image and likeness of God they were suppose to live like they saw Him live. He told them that they were to display the culture of the Kingdom of Heaven, the culture of the House of God.

God wanted them to depend on Him for everything...like children depend on their Father to provide for them, without even thinking about it...so He told them not to eat from a certain tree in the Garden called the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. It was also a simple test as to whether the will of God was sacred in his eyes. Adam failed the test...He broke covenant with God...this caused the curse of sin to enter the world and consequently death thru sin; and so death passed down unto all men.

His actions also brought separation between God and man...between a Father and a son...it turned man from thinking like a son of royalty into thinking like an orphan...orphans are driven by the need for provision, promotion and protection...man no longer relied on their Father to meet these needs. Man was alone and on his own...spiritually dead.

In order to show mankind how to live like He created us to live, God gave us a standard for righteousness called the 10 COMMANDMENTS. But because man was infected by sin through his rebellion, God knew that he could not keep the commandments. Let's take a look at just a few and see how true this is.

God's highest standard of all says that if you have ever broken one of His laws one time at any time, He considers it the same as you being guilty of breaking them all. (Gal.3:10; James 2:10)

Can you see now that God's standard for righteousness is so much higher than ours?

Because sinful man could never live with a HOLY GOD (just like oil & water don't mix), He determined that there had to be a just punishment for sin and that punishment is eternal separation from His presence in Hell. (Ez 18:4 & Is 59:2)

That's our fine for breaking His Law!

The Bible says (Hebrews 9:27; Acts 17:31) that it's appointed unto all men once to die and then face judgement and that man will be judged according to God's standard of righteousness.

So...when you die and stand before God on judgment day and give an account of every thing you have ever done, said, thought or felt, where everything is brought to light, where nothing is hidden from a Holy Omniscient God (2Cor 5:10)....

Will He find you good enough to get into heaven?

DOES THIS CONCERN YOU??

We are here to tell you **THE GOSPEL** which means **GOOD NEWS**.

We are here to open your eyes to His offer of forgiveness, adoption as sons and an awesome inheritance. God the Father fixed it so that we could enjoy the same relationship with Him that Jesus did without compromising His holiness and righteousness. He said that we have not been left as orphans. He makes this possible through His Spirit who comes to live inside of us when we accept His offer of reconciliation.

Ok, so here's what He did...God is made up of three persons – The Father, The Son (Jesus Christ) and The Holy Spirit...it's called the mystery of the Trinity. Before God ever created man, The Son of God covenanted with The Father to lower Himself into the form of a man and live out the sinless life on earth that we were meant to live. He also came to pay the price for the sin that separated us from the Father...the price we should have paid...eternal separation from the Father in hell.

Here is another mystery...Jesus was born of a virgin, so He was fully man, but because of who His Father was He was also fully God. He lived 33 years on the earth as a man and never once committed a sin...**AMAZING!!** Our sins are forgiven and our relationship to the Father has been restored because of what Jesus did. We have been delivered from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of light.

Here are two scriptures that say it best:

- God demonstrated His love for us, that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us (Rom.5:8)
- God made Christ, who knew no sin, to be sin for us, that we may become the righteousness of God, in Christ (2Cor.5:21)

THE GOSPEL (part 2)

In addition to the forgiveness of sins, He also offers us an inheritance which includes 4 basic elements: 1) His presence with us always; 2) partnership with Him in the Family Business (the righteous development and management of all the works of His hands); 3) a specific and unique purpose and calling; and 4) a future glorified, indestructible, eternal body designed to be in His presence forever. We have been restored to our original purpose of demonstrating the life of a son of God...how to live like Jesus lived.

So how did Jesus pay the price for the sin that was meant for us? It's called the blood of the atonement. Jesus, who was innocent of sin, but wrongly convicted of blasphemy, shed His holy blood thru the beatings of the Roman soldiers and the crucifixion. He was crucified on the cross where He absorbed the wrath of God against sin. For the first time in eternity, the Son was separated from the Father. He became an orphan so we could become sons.

After His death on the cross, He descended into hell where He defeated death, the devil and sin. The Father then validated His sacrifice on our behalf by having the Holy Spirit to raise Him from the dead and deliver Him to heaven where He lives now as our interceding High Priest forever. He is the only person ever to be raised from the dead and still live.

CLOSING: The gospel presents Jesus as our Shepherd. He knows His sheep. He died for them. He calls them by name and they hear Him. Are you one of His sheep? Do you hear Him calling you thru what you've just heard? The bottom line is that we are here to tell you that your sins are forgiven and that you need to receive God's offer of reconciliation. You receive it by repentance; belief and confession (see details on next page).

So...will you receive His offer or will you walk away from it?

So what's the next step??

God actually makes the first move when He regenerates (or re-creates) your spirit imperishably. This is a supernatural change that takes place in your heart that the Bible calls being “Born Again”. At the time of this conversion God places within you the gift of repentance and faith.

These new found gifts are activated in you by hearing the gospel. Since you just heard the gospel you may feel these gifts stirring in your heart, if so then your part in the salvation process is to:

Repent - recognize your sins, ask Him to forgive you of them and turn from them.

Believe - believe that the shed blood of Christ is ultimately what satisfies God's justice. Have faith in what Jesus did for you to reconcile you back to God.

Confess - Romans 10:9&10 says: “If you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved [from God's wrath]. For it is with the heart that you believe and are justified and it is with the mouth that confession is made unto salvation.”

There is a prayer on the next page that you can pray as an expression of your newly received gifts of repentance and faith. Sincerity in taking this action is a sign that you are born again.

THE PRAYER

We would encourage you to say this prayer out loud.
(think of a wedding ceremony, where the vows are spoken, not kept quiet).

Lord Jesus

I want to stop trusting myself and what I can do. . . .and start trusting in You and what you have already done. . . .when you died for me on the cross. . . .I know that I'm a sinner and I'm sorry for my sins. . . .I ask You to forgive me for breaking Your Holy Law. . . .I thank You for paying my fine. . . .for paying a debt I could not pay.Thank you for changing my heart. . . .Thank you for the gift of faith, repentance and eternal life. . . . I confess that Jesus is Lord and I believe in the power of His blood. . . .I believe that God raised Him from the dead that I would be saved. . .I ask you Jesus to be the Lord of my life. . . . which means being # 1 in my life. . . . I ask you to baptize me in Your Holy Spirit. . . .I repent and turn away from sin. . . .I totally commit myself to obeying you. . . .everyday for the rest of my life.

THANK YOU JESUS!!!

To grow your new personal relationship with God, it is essential that you:

1. Spend time each day praying and worshipping God. (I Thes 5:17-18)
2. Daily read the Bible and obey what you read.
We recommend starting with the Book of John. (I Peter 2:2)
3. Find a church that teaches the Bible as 100% “The Word of God” and encourages a personal relationship with Jesus. (Heb 10:25)
4. Seek to be water baptized without delay. (Acts 2:38 and 22:16; Rom 6:4)
5. All Christians are to be: filled with the Spirit (Eph 5:18); led by the Spirit; walk in the Spirit; live in the Spirit; sow to the Spirit; and mind the things of the Spirit (Rom 8:5,14; Gal 5:16,25; 6:8).
6. Begin to develop friendships with genuine Christians, those who have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ (I John 1:7).
7. Realize that you are now in a war and you have a 3-fold enemy – the world, the flesh and the devil.
If you crucify your flesh (your old sin nature), the world will have no attraction for you, and the devil will have no foothold in you.
8. Serve. If you know what you have been saved from, you should know what you have been saved for.
Over 140,000 people die every 24 hours. Devote your life to reaching them with the Gospel of salvation. There is no higher calling!
9. Tell other people about your new relationship with God. (Matt 4:19)
10. Memorize scripture. . . .start with Hebrews 13:5 and I John 1:9.

BECAUSE I'M A GOOD PERSON

Jesus said "There are none good but God." (Luke 18:19) Rev 21:8 says the unbelieving sinners, murders, sexually immoral, idolaters and all liars shall have their part in the lake of fire. ICor 6:9-10 says that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God, neither will adulterers, nor homosexuals, not thieves, nor revilers, nor covetous, nor drunkards. Matt 12:36 says you will have to give an account for every idle word spoken on the Day of Judgment.

At the beginning of the parable of the good Samaritan, a certain lawyer asked Jesus what he should do to inherit eternal life as did the rich young ruler in Mark 10. Jesus responded by basically telling them that they had to keep the commandments. If you choose that route to eternal life, the Bible says that the Law is perfect and commands you to be perfect (Matt 5:48). Are you perfect in thought, word and deed?

Even if you break just one of God's commandments you've broken them all. (James 2:10) You maintain you are perfect, but God says you are not. (Ps 14:2-3) Remember, all liars will be cast into the Lake of Fire. Romans 10:3 says you are ignorant of God's righteousness and are seeking to establish your own righteousness having not submitted to the righteousness of God. True righteousness is by faith in Christ, not by works of the Law. Do not stumble at this stumbling stone, or let it fall on you because the Bible says it will grind you to powder.

BECAUSE I'M A GOOD PERSON

God gave you a conscience (moral instinct or moral self-awareness) so you would know right from wrong. Heb 8:10 says He has put His laws in our minds and written them on our hearts. Ecel 3:11 says He has put eternity in our hearts. That's why no one will stand before God on Judgment Day having an excuse for their sinful words, feelings or actions. (Rom 1:20) In fact, the word con-science means with-knowledge. Your conscience compares your sinful actions with the 10 Commandments and brings you under conviction. So every time you lie, cheat, steal, lust or dishonor God, you know in your heart it's wrong.

In Matthew 13, it says that at the end of this age, the Son of Man (Jesus) will send out His angels, and they will gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and those who practice lawlessness, and will cast them into the furnace of fire where there will be wailing and gnashing of teeth, but the righteous (in Christ) will shine forth as the sun in the kingdom of their Father. So, be honest before God and listen to the voice of your conscience.

Are you sure you're good enough to pass the holy judgement of an omniscient God??

You cannot afford to be wrong about where you're going to spend eternity!!

BECAUSE GOD IS GOOD AND HE WILL JUST FORGIVE ME

Perhaps you think because God is good, He will just overlook your sins and forgive you? What if someone kidnapped a loved one of yours and did horrible unspeakable things to her, and then murdered her? Later they catch the guy that did it and the evidence against him is overwhelming. Before passing judgment, the Judge asks “Do you have any final words?” . . .the guy says “Yes Judge. I hear that you’re a really good judge and since I am really sorry for what I did please set me free.” If the Judge said “OK” and then set him free, would you think he was a good judge? No, of course not!!

Does your sense of justice allow you to tolerate the idea that Hitler or Osama bin Laden will come to precisely the same end as the Apostle John? In your deepest soul, do you not find that concept repulsive? If God is good, He must punish all murderers, rapists, thieves, liars, adulterers, etc.

If He didn’t, how good would God be? He would be a corrupt Judge if He turned a blind eye to sin and injustice. **God could never be corrupt.** (Romans 3:4-6)

BECAUSE A GOOD GOD WOULD NOT SEND ANYONE TO HELL

Maybe you're saying "A good God would never send me to Hell!" God is good and He doesn't send anyone to Hell. People send themselves to Hell by turning away from His plan of salvation (John 3:16-18) and trying to get there by doing good deeds. God loved you so much that He showed His love by sending His one and only Son to live a sin-free life and to die as a payment for the sins you committed. (Rom 5:8)

If you trust your own goodness, you're saying that the perfect life Jesus lived and His agonizing death on the cross was in vain. The Bible says "for by grace are you saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God." (Eph 2:8) The word grace means unmerited favor or getting what you don't deserve.

You cannot earn a gift but you can refuse it. Will you Accept God's gift of eternal life or reject it?

I DO NOT BELIEVE IN HELL

Maybe you don't believe in Hell or maybe you do not think that God would ever send anyone there. Even if you don't believe in Hell, it does not change reality. Try jumping from a 25 story building and say "I don't believe in gravity". It won't change reality and the law of gravity will cause you to be crushed as you hit the pavement below. If you ignore God's law, it too will take it's toll and you will be crushed on the Day of Judgment (Luke 20:17-18).

Why did Jesus speak twice as much about Hell in the Bible as He did about Heaven?

1 – The Bible describes Hell as a place of eternal torment with fire and beatings, with no rest day or night, where blackness of darkness is forever, a place of everlasting isolation and punishment, of weeping and gnashing of teeth, where every day is worse than the day before.

2 – Jesus does not want us going there. Hell was created for Satan and his demons.

Are you prepared to pay that kind of price if the Bible is true and Hell is real?

What have you got to loose IF the Bible's wrong and you're right?...Nothing!

But you have eternity to loose if the Bible's right and you are wrong.

BECAUSE I BELIEVE IN GOD

A lot of people think that because they believe in God that makes them a Christian. It's great that you believe in God, but just believing in God won't be enough to get you into Heaven. The Bible says that even "...the demons believe in God and tremble..." (James 2:19), but they will not be going to Heaven. Say you have to jump 20,000 feet out of an airplane and there is a parachute onboard. Would it be enough just to believe in the parachute before you jumped or would you have to put it on to save your life? The Bible says "Put on the Lord Jesus Christ." (Romans 13:14)

So put on the Lord Jesus to escape eternal punishment just like you'd put on a parachute to escape a deadly plane crash.

BECAUSE I GO TO CHURCH

A lot of people think that going to church makes them a Christian and will get them into Heaven. This is a form of trusting in your own efforts to get into Heaven and is saying that the perfect life Jesus lived and His agonizing death on the cross was in vain. The Bible says that it is "by grace you are saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God." (Eph 2:8) You cannot earn a gift but you can refuse it. Will you accept God's gift of eternal life in Heaven or reject it?

CLOSING ARGUMENTS

Don't take the greatest gamble in life by betting your eternal soul against God.

You will loose in a big way! Consider "Pascal's Wager".

"Pascal's Wager" is the name given to an argument due to Blaise Pascal for believing God. Pascal was a French mathematician and physicist from the 1600's and inventor of the first digital calculator and the father of calculus.

His argument goes like this: wagering for God super-dominates wagering against God. The worst outcome associated with wagering for God (i.e. the status quo) is at least as good as the best outcome associated with wagering against God (again, status quo). If God does exist, the prospective prize of wagering for God is an infinity of an infinitely happy life. The prospective prize of wagering against God is an infinity of an infinitely miserable life. Pascal draws the conclusion that rationally requires you to wager for God.

Don't take my word for it...put God to the test. Call on His Son's name and you will see if what the Bible says is true or not...ask God to make Himself real to you...what have you got to lose if the Bible is wrong and you are right...consider however what you have to lose if the Bible is right and you are wrong.

CLOSING ARGUMENTS

If you refuse God's grace, the fact remains that your good deeds won't erase your bad ones. If I murdered someone 10 years ago and then was extremely good thereafter, I would still be a murderer today. One lie makes you a liar. One theft makes you a thief. One lustful look makes you a coveting adulterer. Time does not erase your sins or forgive them!! If you turn away from God's grace, His wrath will still abide on you (Jn3:36) because you didn't accept the sacrifice that He made for you. Instead, if you try to find other ways to enter the Kingdom of Heaven, the Bible says that God sees you as a thief and a robber and such will not enter the Kingdom of Heaven (Jn10:1). One day everyone will see that God, heaven, hell and judgment day are real. . . .how horrific will it be then to find out that hell is real and that you, not God, have sent yourself there for eternity (Rom1:21-32 & Rom 2:5-8).

God has given you a second chance. It is no accident or coincidence that you are reading this. God wants to get your attention. Something you've read or something we've said has stirred you. . . that's God. . . don't ignore it, take it seriously.

3 MINUTES TO LIVE

The Bible says (Heb 9:27; Acts 17:31) that it's appointed unto all men once to die and then face God on judgment day and that man will be judged according to God's standard for righteousness which are the 10 commandments. I'm going to take you thru just a few of the commandments to see if you've kept them...be honest with yourself if you want to be saved...knowing that nothing will be hidden from God on judgment day.

Have you loved God with all your heart, all your mind and all your strength?

Have you ever stolen anything?

Have you ever looked with lust on someone?

Have you ever told a lie?

That's just 4 of the commandments...on judgment day I think it's clear to see that you're going to end up guilty...God knows every sin you've ever committed. God's ultra high standards say that if you have ever broken just one law one time at any time, He considers it the same as you being guilty of breaking them all (James 2:10 & Gal 3:10).

Proverbs 11:4 says that riches profit nothing on the day of wrath, but righteousness delivers from death...**so whose righteousness will you come clothed with on that day?**

THE GOSPEL

- We broke God's Law. Jesus (God's Son) paid our fine (eternal separation from God's presence in Hell).
- His is the only righteousness that God will accept, so you must come clothed with His righteousness on judgement day.
- He was born of a virgin and lived 33 years as a Man in the flesh on the earth and always kept all of God's laws on our behalf, never once committing a sin.
- God placed the death penalty for our sin upon the only person in the universe who could take our place. Though He did not deserve it, Jesus willingly agreed to absorb the wrath of God meant for us by hanging on the cross. God validated Jesus' sacrifice by raising Him from the dead and delivering Him to heaven where He rules and reigns forever as Lord!
- Yes Jesus is Lord and will soon be invading with His armies. He is offering a pardon in advance of His invasion and you should receive His pardon and ally yourself with Him NOW before He invades. When He comes, you will be considered His ally and He will raise you to Kingship. The alternative is to be under the wrath of the King.
- This is not some kind of religious option. It is an announcement that a new King is on the throne and He will be invading. The gospel is not an invitation, but a summons, a command. Will you heed the command? Will you put on the Lord Jesus?
- Jesus **IS** Lord...repent and believe!!

ARE YOU SURE YOU'RE AN ATHEIST?

TEST # ONE

Consider this statement: "There is no gold in China."

What do I need to have for that statement to be true:

- A) No knowledge of China
- B) Partial knowledge of China
- C) Absolute knowledge of China.

To make the absolute statement, "There is no God.", I must have absolute knowledge that there is no God . . . in other words, I must be omniscient. But since we know you are not omniscient, let's just say that you possess an incredible 1% of all knowledge. Is it possible that within the knowledge you haven't yet come across, there is ample evidence to prove that God does indeed exist? If you are reasonable, you will have to say, "Having the limited knowledge I now possess, I believe that there is no God." Since you do not know for certain that God does not exist, you are not an "atheist", you are what is commonly known as an "agnostic". You are like a man who looks at a building and doesn't know if there was a builder.

TEST # TWO

The man who sees a building and doesn't know if there was a builder:



Romans 1:19-20 – "For what can be made known about God is plain to [all men], because God has shown it to them. For His invisible attributes . . . have been clearly perceived . . . in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse."

ARE YOU SURE YOU'RE AN ATHEIST?

Consider the eye – did you know that the eye has 40M nerve endings, the focusing muscles move an estimated 100K times per day, and the retina contains 137M light sensitive cells?

Psalms 94:9 says “He who planted the ear, does He not hear? He who formed the eye, Does He not see?” Proverbs 20:12 says “The hearing ear and the seeing eye, the Lord has made them both.” Charles Darwin said: “To suppose that the eye could have been formed by natural selection seems I freely confess, absurd in the highest degree.”
