- All shirts with writing or graphics must be pre-approved or turned inside out.

Men's Dress Code

Women's Dress Code

Please wear your volunteer t-shirt with a jeans/pants, knee length shorts/skirts or a knee length dress; no mini-skirts or short shorts, rips, holes, cut-offs please.
