

Baptism in the Holy Spirit

Read 1Corinthians 12 & 14

Matthew 3:11 John the Baptist declares Jesus as the Baptizer. Matthew 3:11 (Amplified Bible)

I indeed baptize you [a]in (with) water [b]because of repentance [that is, because of your [c]changing your minds for the better, heartily amending your ways, with abhorrence of your past sins]. But He Who is coming after me is mightier than I, Whose sandals I am not worthy or fit to take off or carry; He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

Mark 1:8 Baptize with the Holy Spirit - Mark 1:8 (Amplified Bible)

I have baptized you with water, but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.

Mark 1:10 Jesus was baptized by John and received the Holy Spirit -Mark 1:10 (Amplified Bible)

And when He came up out of the water, at once he [John] saw the heavens torn open and the [Holy] Spirit like a dove coming down [[a]to enter] [b]into Him.(A)

John 1:32-33 The Holy Spirit came upon Jesus and remained. Jesus baptizes in the Holy Spirit. John 1:32-33 (Amplified Bible)

32John gave further evidence, saying, I have seen the Spirit descending as a dove out of heaven, and it dwelt on Him [never to depart].

33And I did not know Him nor recognize Him, but He Who sent me to baptize [a]in (with) water said to me, Upon Him Whom you shall see the Spirit descend and remain, that One is He Who baptizes with the Holy Spirit.

John 7:37-39 Out of your innermost parts will flow Rivers of Living Water (39) Prophetic of the Holy Spirit coming on Believers after Jesus is glorified. John 7:37-39 (Amplified Bible)

37Now on the final and most important day of the Feast, Jesus stood, and He cried in a loud voice, If any man is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink!

38He who believes in Me [who cleaves to and trusts in and relies on Me] as the Scripture has said, From his innermost being shall flow [continuously] springs and rivers of living water.

39But He was speaking here of the Spirit, Whom those who believed (trusted, had faith) in Him were afterward to receive. For the [Holy] Spirit had not yet been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified (raised to honor).

John 13:16-19 My Father will give you the Holy Spirit to empower you as He empowered Me (Jesus). John 13:16-19 (Amplified Bible)

16I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, A servant is not greater than his master, and no one who is sent is superior to the one who sent him.

17If you know these things, blessed and happy and [a]to be envied are you if you practice them [if you act accordingly and really do them].

18I am not speaking of and I do not mean all of you. I know whom I have chosen; but it is that the Scripture may be fulfilled, He who eats [b]My bread with Me has raised up his heel against Me.(A)

19I tell you this now before it occurs, so that when it does take place you may be persuaded and believe that I am He [Who I say I am--the Christ, the Anointed One, the Messiah].

John 14:25-27 The Holy Spirit's job is to give power and teach. John 14:25-27 (Amplified Bible)

25I have told you these things while I am still with you.

26But the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you.

27Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]

John 15:26-27 The Holy Spirit testifies about Jesus and the Father. John 15:26-27 (Amplified Bible)

26But when the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengtheners, Standby) comes, Whom I will send to you from the Father, the Spirit of Truth Who comes (proceeds) from the Father, He [Himself] will testify regarding Me.

27But you also will testify and be My witnesses, because you have been with Me from the beginning.

John 16:12-15 It is impossible to understand what Jesus' death and resurrection has accomplished without the Holy Spirit teaching. John 16:12-15 (Amplified Bible)

12I have still many things to say to you, but you are not able to bear them or to take them upon you or to grasp them now.

13But when He, the Spirit of Truth (the Truth-giving Spirit) comes, He will guide you into all the Truth (the whole, full Truth). For He will not speak His own message [on His own authority]; but He will tell whatever He hears [from the Father; He will give the message that has been given to Him], and He will announce and declare to you the things that are to come [that will happen in the future].

14He will honor and glorify Me, because He will take of (receive, draw upon) what is Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

15Everything that the Father has is Mine. That is what I meant when I said that He [the Spirit] will take the things that are Mine and will reveal (declare, disclose, transmit) it to you.

Luke 24:49 Jesus told His disciples to wait until they be clothed with Power. Luke 24:49 (Amplified Bible)

49And behold, I will send forth upon you what My Father has promised; but remain in the city [Jerusalem] until you are clothed with power from on high.

Acts 1:5-8 You receive Power when the Holy Spirit comes. Acts 1:5-8 (Amplified Bible)

5For John baptized with water, but not many days from now you shall be baptized with ([a]placed in, introduced into) the Holy Spirit.

6So when they were assembled, they asked Him, Lord, is this the time when You will reestablish the kingdom and restore it to Israel?

7He said to them, It is not for you to become acquainted with and know [b]what time brings [the things and events of time and their definite periods] or fixed [c]years and seasons (their critical niche in time), which the Father has appointed (fixed and reserved) by His own choice and authority and personal power.

8But you shall receive power (ability, efficiency, and might) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My witnesses in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth

Acts 2:1-4 First Time: Filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke in tongues. Acts 2:1-4 (Amplified Bible)

Acts 2 for the Jews

1AND WHEN the day of Pentecost had fully come, they were all assembled together in one place,

2When suddenly there came a sound from heaven like the rushing of a violent tempest blast, and it filled the whole house in which they were sitting.

3And there appeared to them tongues resembling fire, which were separated and distributed and which settled on each one of them.

4And they were all filled (diffused throughout their souls) with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other (different, foreign) languages (tongues), as the Spirit [a]kept giving them clear and loud expression [in each tongue in appropriate words].

Acts 10:44-46 God always does everything right the first time. Acts 10:44-46 (Amplified Bible)

44While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell on all who were listening to the message.

45And the believers from among the circumcised [the Jews] who came with Peter were surprised and amazed, because the free gift of the Holy Spirit had been bestowed and poured out largely even on the Gentiles.

46For they heard them talking in [unknown] tongues (languages) and extolling and magnifying God. Then Peter asked,

Acts 19:4-6 Water Baptism and Baptism in the Holy Spirit. Acts 19:4-6 (Amplified Bible)

4And Paul said, John baptized with the baptism of repentance, continually telling the people that they should believe in the One Who was to come after him, that is, in Jesus [having a conviction full of joyful trust that He is Christ, the Messiah, and being obedient to Him].

5On hearing this they were baptized [again, this time] in the name of the Lord Jesus.

6And as Paul laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came on them; and they spoke in [foreign, unknown] tongues (languages) and prophesied.

Acts 9:3-6 Saul (Paul) His great conversion. Acts 9:3-6 (Amplified Bible)

3Now as he traveled on, he came near to Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him,

4And he fell to the ground. Then he heard a voice saying to him, Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me [harassing, troubling, and molesting Me]?

5And Saul said, Who are You, Lord? And He said, I am Jesus, Whom you are persecuting. [a]It is dangerous and it will turn out badly for you to keep kicking against the goad [to offer vain and perilous resistance].

6Trembling and astonished he asked, Lord, what do You desire me to do? The Lord said to him, But arise and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do.

Acts 9:17 Saul (Paul) His infilling with the Holy Spirit. Acts 9:17 (Amplified Bible)

17So Ananias left and went into the house. And he laid his hands on Saul and said, Brother Saul, the Lord Jesus, Who appeared to you along the way by which you came here, has sent me that you may recover your sight and be filled with the Holy Spirit.

How to Receive. Luke 11:11-13 Be Saved, Ask the Father and Believe Luke 11:11-13 (Amplified Bible)

11What father among you, if his son asks for [a]a loaf of bread, will give him a stone; or if he asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent?

12Or if he asks for an egg, will give him a scorpion?

13If you then, evil as you are, know how to give good gifts [gifts [b]that are to their advantage] to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask and [c]continue to ask Him!

Rewards.

Perfect Prayer Romans 8:26-27 (Amplified Bible)

26So too the [Holy] Spirit comes to our aid and bears us up in our weakness; for we do not know what prayer to offer nor how to offer it worthily as we ought, but the Spirit Himself goes to meet our supplication and pleads in our behalf with unspeakable yearnings and groanings too deep for utterance.

27And He Who searches the hearts of men knows what is in the mind of the [Holy] Spirit [what His intent is], because the Spirit intercedes and pleads [before God] in behalf of the saints according to and in harmony with God's will.(A)

Builds You Up Jude 1:20 Jude 1:20 (Amplified Bible)

20But you, beloved, build yourselves up [founded] on your most holy faith [[a]make progress, rise like an edifice higher and higher], praying in the Holy Spirit;

Anoints You for God's Work 1John 2:20-27 1 John 2:20-27 (Amplified Bible)

20But you have been anointed by [you hold a sacred appointment from, you have been given an unction from] the Holy One, and you all know [the Truth] or you know all things.

21I write to you not because you are ignorant and do not perceive and know the Truth, but because you do perceive and know it, and [know positively] that nothing false (no deception, no lie) is of the Truth.

22Who is [such a] liar as he who denies that Jesus is the Christ (the Messiah)? He is the antichrist (the antagonist of Christ), who [[a]habitually] denies and refuses to acknowledge the Father and the Son.

23No one who [[b]habitually] denies (disowns) the Son [c]even has the Father. Whoever confesses (acknowledges and has) the Son has the Father also.

24As for you, keep in your hearts what you have heard from the beginning. If what you heard from the first dwells and remains in you, then you will dwell in the Son and in the Father [always].

25And this is what He Himself has promised us--the life, the eternal [life].

26I write this to you with reference to those who would deceive you [seduce and lead you astray].

27But as for you, the anointing (the sacred appointment, the unction) which you received from Him abides [[d]permanently] in you; [so] then you have no need that anyone should instruct you. But just as His anointing teaches you concerning everything and is true and is no falsehood, so you must abide in (live in, never depart from) Him [being [e]rooted in Him, knit to Him], just as [His anointing] has taught you [to do].
