

Operation Care International – Outreach to the Homeless

What: Sharing the gospel with approximately 12,000 homeless people. Please consider a special time of prayer and fasting leading up to the event...this will give you the best chance to be as prepared as possible.

When: Saturday December 21, 2013

Max Time Commitment: Arrive at the registration area no later than 6:45 am and leave for home no later than 4:00 pm. The location for registration is shown on Attachment # 1 (Convention Floor Plan) and Attachment # 2 (Parking & Convention Site Plan).

Pre-Event Training: There is an on-line power point type training session that takes 8.5 minutes to view. I would recommend viewing it at least twice. We will also cover everything you need to know during our orientation session on Saturday morning. Session One Orientation 7:00am – 7:30am; General Meeting 7:30am; Session Two Orientation 7:30 am - 8:00 am.

- Next you will see a screen that says (in red) “Evangelism Team”. Click on “Training English”.
- You will spend the next 8.5 minutes viewing a power point presentation of the basics of how this outreach works.
- See Attachment # 3 (Evangelism Survey). This is a front & back form that each guest will be bringing with them as you meet them...effectively it is their ticket to receive gifts. Others before you will have assisted our guests in filling in the gray shaded areas on the back of the form. Your job is to assist them with the non-shaded areas on the front and back of the form.

This survey form is how we do the gospel presentation. Please become familiar with it between now and Saturday. This is the most important thing you will be doing!

Pre-Event Registration:

- Next you will see a screen that says (in red) “Evangelism Team”. Click on “To sign up as a volunteer, please click here.” Fill out the requested information.
- Where it says: “What hours are you available?”...Sign up for both shifts if at all possible.
- Where it says Evangelism Area...Single Adults... Families.
. If you want to work with Wayne Morris and Mike Prather, sign up for Single Adults.
. If you want to work for Dwayne Pipkins or Douglas Raine, sign up for Families.
- Be sure to check agree on the doctrinal statement and click on submit and you are finished.

Schedule Breakdown:

- 6:45 am to 7:40 am – Registration...this is where and when you pick up your name tag if you have pre-registered. If have not pre-registered, this is where you register and get your name badge.
- 7:00 to 7:30 am Session 1 – Orientation/Training...all evangelists assemble in the “Adult Homeless Evangelism” area per Attachment # 1 (Convention Floor Plan).
- 7:30 am General Meeting

- 7:30 am – 8:00 am Session 2 – Orientation Training...assemble in the “Adult Homeless Evangelism area
 - 8:00 to 8:30 am – Those working on the Family Evangelism Team move to your station. Those working on the Single Adult Homeless Evangelism Team, stay put.
 - 8:30am to 4:00pm – Guests arrive and gospel work begins.
- Where: Dallas Convention Center -650 S Griffin St, Dallas, TX 75202-5098.

Parking: See Attachment # 2 (Parking & Convention Site Plan) for options. Please plan to be parked by 6:45 am. You might also consider taking the DART rail which drops off at the other end of the convention center, although you would have to check DART for time schedules. Both the DART Red and Blue lines come to the Dallas Convention (Union Station). Convention parking will open at 5:30AM.

What to wear: We will be indoors but getting from your car to the entry will likely require a coat (check forecast as we approach the time). We are asking you to wear a red shirt or red jacket or sweatshirt so you will be identified as a volunteer. Team leaders will be wearing a lime green tee shirt that says "ASK ME." You may purchase the official OCD red tee shirts when you arrive for \$15 depending on size.

Drink & Food: Water will be provided by OCI in our work area. Food -you can enjoy OCD provided lunch in the food service area near the main stage.

What else to bring:

- Please bring some pens (clip boards will be provided).
- Complete Attachment # 4 (Integrity Pledge & Waiver) and turn it in when you pick up your name badge at Registration.
- Complete Attachment # 5 (Doctrinal Statement) and keep it with you for presentation to whomever may ask for it.
- Also please consider bringing a \$10 (or greater) love offering (given at registration) to help OCI meet the budget (cash or check).
